

**930 Hawkins Road (Jill O'Neal House), 1948, Richard E. Carney,
architect**



This house was designed in 1946 and 1947 and was constructed in 1948. The architect was Richard Edgar Carney, who was attending Washington University School of Architecture and served as a personal aid to Frank Lloyd Wright from 1952 to 1959. After Wright's death in 1959 Carney worked for the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation and was later chief executive officer. The house is integrated into the hillside on which it stands and is made of glass cedar, concrete and native stone. Carney's design for this house was greatly influenced by Frank Lloyd Wright.
