7087	04/08/74	Adopts the 1971 BOCA Mechanical Code, in addition to adding Appendices A through M and 1972 Accumulative Supplement to the 1970 BOCA Building Code in effect.
7663	11/28/75	Adopts the 1975 BOCA Mechanical Code in addition to adopting the 1975 BOCA Building Code with Appendices A through M
9716	05/16/80	Adopts the 1978 BOCA Basic Mechanical Code with Appendices A through E, in addition to adopting the 1978 BOCA Basic Building Code with Appendices A through M
11719	10/05/84	Creates Chapter 1108 and adopts the 1984 BOCA Basic National Mechanical Code as amended and establishes a fee schedule.
14079	09/16/88	Repeals Chapter 1108, and enacts a new Chapter 1108 and adopts the 1987 BOCA National Mechanical Code as amended. Created a new Article 22 regulating Amusement Devices.
14617	09/29/89	Amends Chapter 1108 by adding three new sections authorizing the Code Official to seal out of service any unsafe equipment.
16914	03/21/94	Repeals Chapter 1108, enacts a new Chapter 1108 and adopts the 1993 BOCA National Mechanical Code as amended.
20236	12/03/00	Repeals Chapter 1108, enacts a new Chapter 1108 and adopts the 1998 International Mechanical Code as amended. Adopts licensing requirements for certain mechanical equipment work.
20694	11/14/01	Amends licensing requirements.
22,313	05/18/05 Effective 9/1/05	Repealed and re-enacted Chapter 1108 and adopts the 2003 edition of the International Mechanical Code, as published by the International Code Council.
23,533	02/20/08	Amended Periodic Mechanical Equipment Inspection Fees
24,438	07/14/10 Effective 11/1/10	Repealed and re-enacted Chapter 1108 and adopts the 2009 edition of the International Mechanical Code, as published by the International Code Council.
24,624	12/14/10	Amended Section 101 regarding Licensing of Persons or Entities performing work as a HVAC Servicer-Installer.
25,688	02/12/2014	Clarifications made to Section 101 regarding licensing. Established fee for extending time limitations on waiving of fees for declared disasters. Clarifications made to violations/penalty sections. Add new definitions to the amusement section.
27,619	12/5/19	Repealed and enacted Chapter 1108 and adopts the 2015 edition of the International Mechanical Code. Effective date 4/1/20
