

NOTICE TO INDUSTRY

Requesting Input for Mechanical Licensing Tests

September 29, 2016

Industry has requested that St Louis County update the current Mechanical Licensing Journeyman Tests to include revised core & trade questions. This update will require volunteers from the industry to meet on several occasions to provide input on testing matters within their trade.

The focus of review will include the content areas of Journeyman tests, percentage of questions in each area and the references required for testing. The format will be multiple group meetings lasting 2 to 4 hours with email correspondence between meetings. The contracted test provider will generate additional test questions based on the recommendations from the group and approval by the Mechanical Licensing Board.

Volunteers should have knowledge of St Louis County Mechanical Ordinance & Codes, be familiar with training curriculum of one of the following mechanical trades; Pipefitting, Sheet Metal, Sprinkler Fitter or HVAC Commercial/Residential, and to have the availability to complete this important task.
